



- It is recommended to adjust the columns to the desired height before installing the display.

1. Assembling the Base




Attach the right base to the middle base and secure with screws (P). Repeat this step for the left base.




NOTE: Lock the brakes on the casters to avoid any sudden movements during installation.
Each caster can be adjusted independently for fine tuning adjustments. Slightly turn the nut to lower or raise the base.

2. Attaching the Column to the Base




Attach the column to the base using the screws and washers.

Pull the pin outwards and pull the inner column upwards at the same time, until the inner column is pulled to the desired height then release the pin to secure.




3. Attaching the Universal Plate to the Column





Attach the universal plate to the column using the appropriate screws.
